

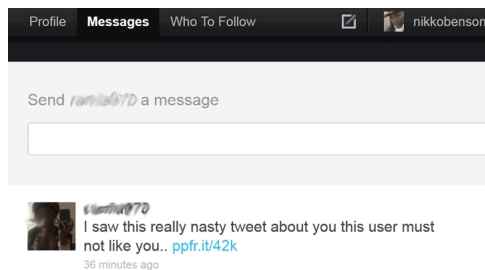
How To Get Rid Of the Twitter SPAM Virus

It begins with a tweet that looks innocent enough:

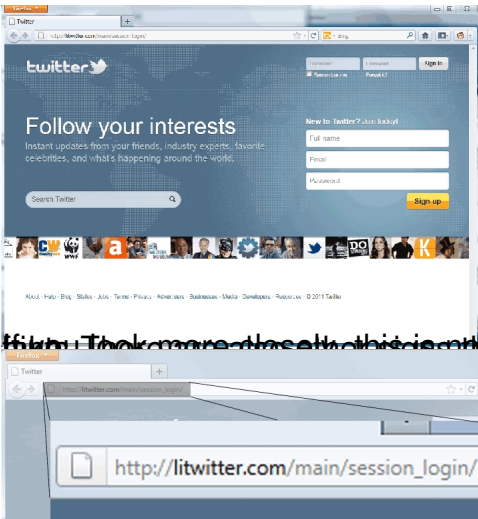


Once you click the link you're taken to what appears to be a Twitter login page. At this point most people would simply enter their username and password and sign in. But this is where the trouble starts.

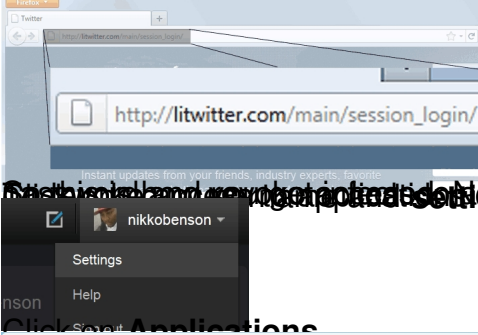

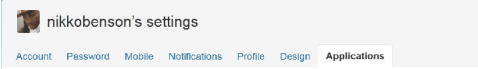

First, take a look at the page litwitter.com and see what it looks like. It's a little



Next, go to your account settings and click on the 'Applications' tab. You'll see a list of applications that have access to your account. Find all unknown or unused applications and click **Revoke Access** next to them.



You're all set. Your friends should stop receiving SPAM messages from you.
